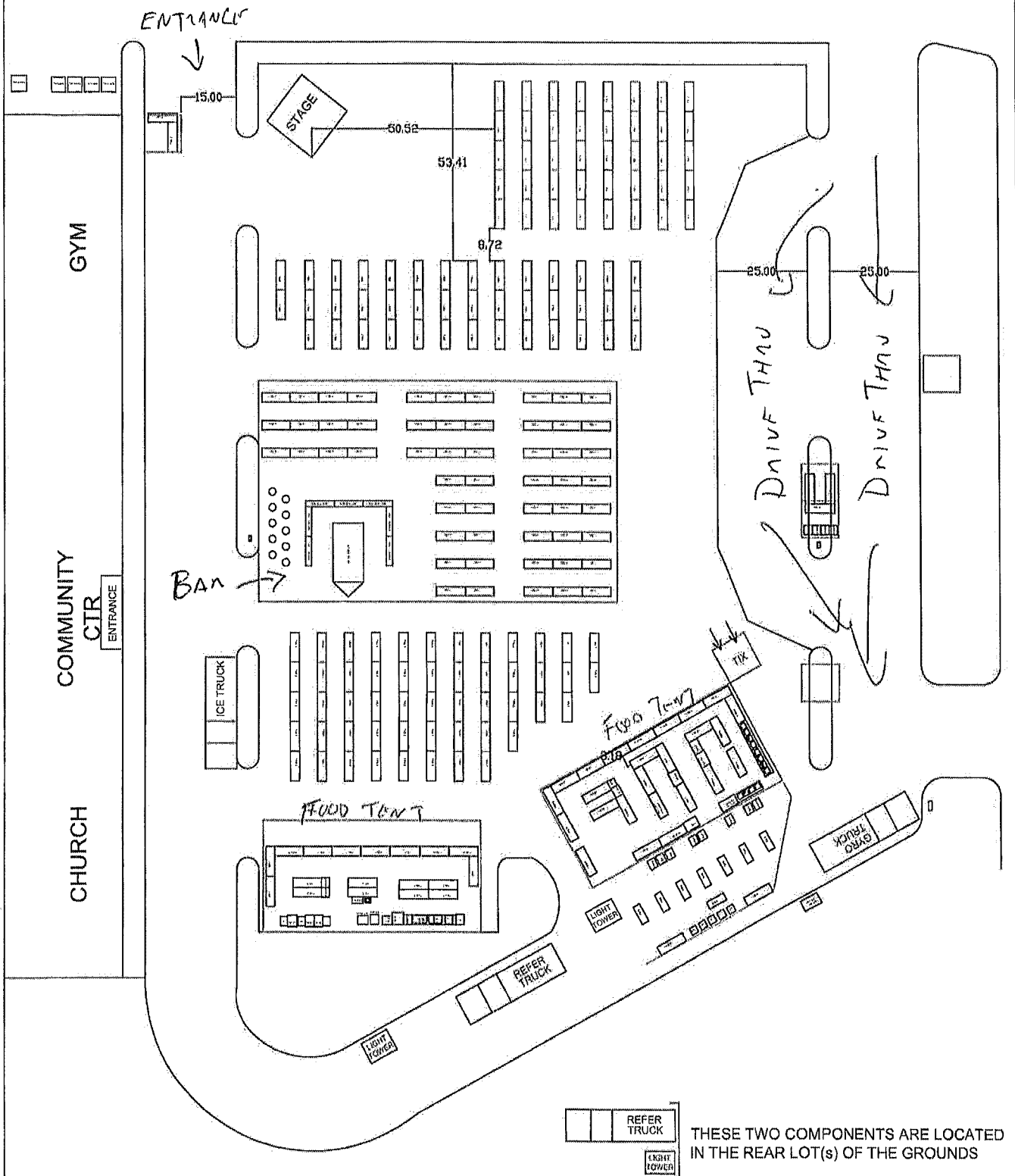

We are intending to start an upscale liquor store at 44 W Illinois Ave, Palatine, IL 60067. This used to be JJ Pepper store.

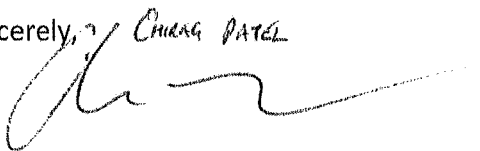

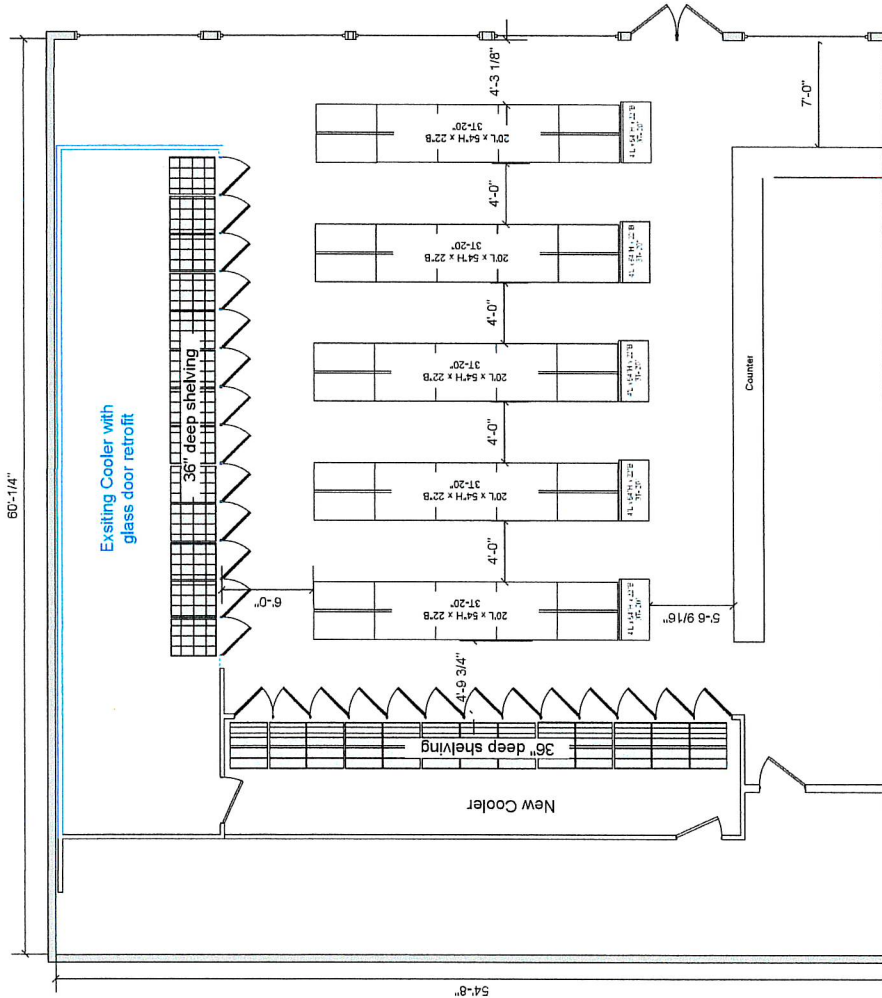

Consider an Application for a Class D-1 Liquor License for T. J. O'Brien's Inc. Located at 53 W. Slade Street

BACKGROUND: Section 3-34 of the Alcoholic Beverages Code requires that each person who acquires in excess of 5% of the total issued and outstanding stock of the corporation shall report to the local liquor control commission not less than 30 days prior to such acquisition. If the change in ownership is 50% or more of the shares, a new liquor license must be issued.

An update of the stock ownership for T. J. O'Brien's reflects that Jennifer Brey and Frank Brey each own 50% of the stock for T. J. O'Brien's, Inc. The original liquor application listed Jennifer Brey with 100% ownership dating back to 2017 with their initial license based upon materials submitted by the establishment. Pursuant to Village Code a new license is required.

KEY ISSUES:

A copy of the application and stock certificates are on file in the Village Manager's office.

The new liquor license will replace the existing license and expire on June 30th at which time the D-1 classification also is eliminated.

ALTERNATIVES

1. Approve the D-1 liquor license.
2. Do not approve the D-1 liquor license.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the issuance of a new D-1 Liquor License..
